Severna Park Baptist Church considers a wedding to be a service of worship given to the glory of God. The Pastor offers this service in thanksgiving to God and in honor of the couple to be married. The Pastor has the right to refuse to conduct the ceremony if his biblical convictions are violated. The following information is provided to you so that your wedding ceremony will be a meaningful and spiritual experience.

A service of Christian marriage is provided for couples who wish to dedicate their marriage in an act of worship before God. The ceremony will be a witness unto God that this is a Christian service through the sharing of Scripture, prayer and exchange of vows. Everything that is done during the ceremony is for the glory of God.

The marriage vows and the exchange of rings are a solemn vow before God. The marriage covenant is not to be entered into lightly or unadvisedly, but thoughtfully and prayerfully. Therefore, premarital counseling is required of all couples desiring to be married at Severna Park Baptist Church.

Family and friends who come to celebrate your wedding ceremony are encouraged to be active participants rather than passive witnesses. They give their blessing to you and your marriage by their presence, prayers and words of encouragement.

Wedding Guidelines

1. All weddings at Severna Park Baptist Church (SPBC) shall be conducted as Christian ceremonies, reflecting the biblical principles between a man and a woman. Only weddings approved by SPBC Pastors shall be allowed.
2. All calendar dates for weddings must be approved by SPBC. Weddings around Christmas/Easter holidays must accommodate existing décor with little exception.
3. All weddings will be conducted by a SPBC approved church-ordained minister. Please list the minister if coming from outside SPBC. Each minister has his own policies and customs which he will share with you.
4. Premarital counseling is required of all couples desiring to be married and must be arranged with the Pastor. At least two-three sessions are usually sufficient for discussing various marital topics.
5. A wedding rehearsal is conducted to eliminate unnecessary confusion on the wedding day. The time & date will be set during initial counseling sessions.
6. No substance abuse is to be used on church property. If substance abuse is detected in any of the wedding party, he/she will not be allowed to participate. Please also refrain from smoking on church property.
7. Photography and video recording are allowed during the ceremony. The pastor will offer suggestions and guidelines during the rehearsal.
8. All music that is to be used during the ceremony must be reviewed by the pastor. All CD/DVD (etc.) being used must be submitted to the pastor no later than one week prior to rehearsal date.

9. *No birdseed, rice, confetti or bubbles are to be used inside church property. Please wait until outside or at the reception for this tradition.*
10. *Only authorized church personnel will take care of operating heating/air systems, sound and lighting systems.*
11. *It is the responsibility of the user to ensure all outside contractors such as florist, caterers, musicians, photographers, etc. clean up after themselves and remove all equipment same day of wedding.*
12. *All SPBC furniture or items moved due to wedding ceremony must be put back in order as found.*
13. *It is the responsibility of the user to ensure all persons present abide by given guidelines. If damages or loss of church property occur due to user or user's guests or user's contractor's then user is responsible. Expenses above the security deposit may be charged if needed.*
14. *A written contract must be signed by both the bride and groom for approval by SPBC.*

Wedding Fees

Mandatory for Non-Member's

1. \$600 Facility Use (includes building usage, audio/visual support, custodial, and incidentals).
2. \$200 of the \$600 should be a security deposit provided at least 1-month before wedding for holding the date. The security deposit will be refunded if no damages.
3. \$300 Pastor (includes pre-marital counseling, ceremony services, building coordination, etc.)

Optional

4. \$TBD Musical or Solo Accompanist.

SPBC Members Only

Active Members of SPBC for six (6) months or more and in good standing may have facility use fee removed; security deposits are for all ceremonies. A/V Tech, Musical Accompanist and Pastor services may be negotiated upon mutual agreement. Custodial fees cannot be removed. All contracts and deposits must be turned in no later than one month prior to the wedding date.

SAMPLE Wedding Ceremony

This is a typical sample wedding ceremony. In general the pastor is flexible for the ceremony and order. However, he may have some suggestions for how to best transition from one to another. Please select this order with your pastor as soon as possible and schedule a rehearsal date, which is mandatory for all wedding participants. All music will be arranged with one of our accompanists; any CD's or solos in ceremony should be previewed by pastor. Likewise, all personally written vows that will be in the ceremony should be previewed by the pastor.

Exchange of Vows:

Believing that you both have considered the sacredness of the covenant of marriage, I will now ask you to join your right hands.

Groom, in taking **Bride** to be your wedded wife, you must promise before the Lord and the witnesses present that you will love her, esteem her and encourage her in that relationship and leaving all others you will unite as one with her in marriage. By God's grace, you will have the responsibility to serve and share in all things at all times and in all ways as a true and faithful husband as long as you both shall live. Do you make that promise to the Lord and to **Bride**?

Respond: "I Will" OR "I Do"

Bride, in taking **Groom** to be your wedded husband, you must promise before the Lord and the witnesses present that you will love him, esteem him and encourage him in that relationship and leaving all others you will unite as one with him in marriage. By God's grace, you will have the responsibility to serve and share in all things at all times and in all ways as a true and faithful wife as long as you both shall live. Do you make that promise to the Lord and to **Groom**?

Respond: "I Will" OR "I Do"

Groom, I'd like for you to look your bride in the eyes and repeat this vow after me to her:

"I, **Groom**, take thee **Bride**, to be my wife, to have and to hold, to love and to cherish, for richer or poorer, for better or worse, in sickness and in health, till death do us part."

Bride, I'd like for you to look **Groom** in the eyes and repeat this vow after me to him:

"I, **Bride**, take thee **Groom**, to be my husband, to have and to hold, to love and to cherish, for richer or poorer, for better or worse, in sickness and in health, till death do us part."

Exchange of Rings:

In Biblical covenants there would often be a symbol representing the covenant made between the parties. **Groom & Bride** have chosen these rings as the seal and as the symbol of their wedding covenant.

Groom, as a ceaseless reminder of this hour and of the vows that you are making to the Lord and to **Bride**, I want you to place this ring on her left hand and repeat after me to her: "With this ring, I thee wed."

Bride, as a ceaseless reminder of this hour and of the vows that you are making to the Lord and to **Groom**, I want you to place this ring on his left hand and repeat after me to him: "With this ring, I thee wed."
